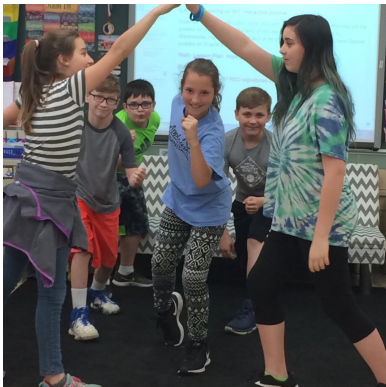


RESIDENCIES

Engage your students in a five-session arts-integrated program around a curricular topic of your choice. Our residencies use drama activities to get students on their feet and examine source material from a new perspective, deepening their understanding. Choose from various styles of residency including: Bringing Books to Life, Creative Lens, Dramatic Interpretation, Character Creation, Living Museum, Monologue Writing and Public Speaking. Residencies take place at your school.

ENRICHMENT WORKSHOPS

In these one-session workshops, students learn the basics of a theater arts specialty. Choose from several workshops including: Actor's Toolbox, Designers Viewpoint, Careers in Theatre, Public Speaking and Improvisation. Enrichment workshops can take place at your school or at the theatre based on availability.



AFTER-SCHOOL ACTING CLASSES

Our after-school acting classes for grades PK-6 explore drama skills in a fun and supportive environment. Each session of class focuses on a different aspect of performing and culminates in an informal sharing for family and friends. Fall, winter, and spring classes take place once a week for six to twelve weeks at your school.



BACKSTAGE TOURS

Bring your students to the Playhouse for a behind-the-scenes tour of Cincinnati's Tony Award-winning theatre! Tours include information on the Playhouse's history and the day-to-day workings of a professional regional theatre.

THE PLAYHOUSE OUTREACH TOUR

Our Touring Company delivers professional theatre right to your school! Each play is selected for a specific age range and address grade-level appropriate, state academic standards in English, language arts, fine arts, health and wellness, and arts and humanities. Each show runs approximately 45-60 minutes and is followed by a Q&A with the cast, as time allows.



STUDENT MATINEES

Schools are invited to attend special weekday performances of our mainstage productions. Each play includes a Q&A session with the cast, and an educator's guide.



PRE- AND POST-SHOW WORKSHOPS

Pre-show workshops prepare your students for their matinee performance while post-show workshops encourage students to think deeper about the play. Each of these one-session workshops can be booked separately or in tandem. Pre-show workshops take place at your school. Post-show workshops can take place at your school or at the theatre after your performance, based on availability.



PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Apply the elements of theatre to your teaching practice through our Professional Development workshops for educators. Workshops are customized to serve your school's specific needs and can take place at your school or at the Playhouse. Corporate workshops are also available.
