THEATRES AND SPECIAL EVENT SPACES

Moe and Jack's Place – The Rouse Theatre (537/510 seat capacity)

Event during the run of a show on an established set \$840 per event

Event during the summer or when the theatre is empty \$1,050 per event

Includes use of the space from 8 am – 11:59 pm on the event day for load-in, technical work, rehearsal, up to a 2 ½ hour event, and load-out; production manager; house managers and house assistants; and volunteer ushers. Stagehand labor and equipment rental costs are additional and can be estimated only with detailed production information in writing.

Load-in, technical, rehearsal or load-out day \$735 per day

Includes use of the space from 8 am – 11:59 pm on the day for load-in, technical work, rehearsal, or load-out; and a production manager. Stagehand labor and equipment rental costs are additional and can be estimated only with detailed production information in writing.

Weekly rates upon request

Rosenthal Shelterhouse Theatre (172 seat capacity) \$525 per event

Includes use of the space from 8 am – 11:59 pm on the event day for load-in, technical work, rehearsal, up to a 2 ½ hour event, and load-out; production manager; house managers and house assistants; and volunteer ushers. Stagehand labor and equipment rental costs are additional and can be estimated only with detailed production information in writing.

Load-in, technical, rehearsal or load-out day \$325 per day

Includes use of the space from 8 am – 11:59 pm on the day for load-in, technical work, rehearsal, or load-out; and a production manager. Stagehand labor and equipment rental costs are additional and can be estimated only with detailed production information in writing.

Schueler and Upper Lobbies (400 standing capacity) \$1,600 per event

Barbara M. Weyand Donor Lounge (25 capacity, seating for 20) \$450 per event

Kaplan Lobby and Alcove (70 standing capacity, seating for 40) \$550 per event

Room with a View (40 standing capacity, seating for 14) \$400 per event

Schiff Education Studio (34' x 50'; 250 standing capacity) \$800 per event

Rouse Rehearsal Room (23' x 29'; 100 standing capacity) \$325 per event

Additional hours in Special event spaces \$55 per hour or portion thereof

All special event space includes use of the space for 4 hours; standard furniture; and venue management personnel. Other labor and equipment rental costs are additional and can be estimated only with detailed production information in writing.

Special event space capacity can vary depending on room set-up.

Non-profit organizations receive a 10% discount on room rental fees only; documentation of non-profit status must be provided to qualify.

Event Crew (4-hour minimum)	\$85/4-hours per person
Custodial Crew	\$120/event
Overnight Custodial Crew (for Monday evening events during the season and weekends during the summer)	\$365

Theatre events longer than 2 ½ hours	\$100/hour or portion thereof
Events occurring past midnight	\$150/hour or portion thereof
